



FirstNet in Latin America

Get details on unlimited talk, text and data in Latin American countries for FirstNet

There's no charge for roaming in 20 Latin American countries, with FirstNet Premium 2.0 and FirstNet Elite 2.0 plans.

What to know:

Do you have a FirstNet Premium 2.0 or FirstNet Elite 2.0?

FirstNet users get unlimited talk, text and data at no extra cost when traveling in or between these 20 Latin American countries:

- **In Central America:** Belize, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Nicaragua and Panama
- **In South America:** Argentina, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Ecuador, Guyana, Paraguay, Peru, Suriname, Uruguay and Venezuela

While in one of these countries, you can also call and text the U.S. and the [210+ destinations](#) if you have Premium 2.0 plan or FirstNet Elite 2.0 plan – at no additional cost.

Calling other countries will incur long-distance call and text charges or pay-per-use rates.

FYI: You only get this feature when traveling to and between these countries. It doesn't include international long distance when calling from the U.S. to these countries.

Important details

Coverage and data speeds vary by country. International usage should not exceed domestic usage.

Will my phone work in Mexico like it does in the U.S.?

Yes. Your wireless plan is subject to the same data rules in Mexico as it is in the U.S., although network speeds can be slower outside of the U.S. (as low as 2G).

Can I call Mexico at no extra cost from the U.S. on my FirstNet Plans?

Calling Mexico from your FirstNet phone does not add any costs to your monthly plan. You can call Mexico and Canada from the U.S. without paying long-distance fees.

What happens if I use my FirstNet phone more in Mexico than in the U.S.?

Nothing! Other carriers have a 50/50 rule that controls how much time you can spend on your phone in either country. AT&T does not.

Do I need to have two separate phones – one phone for the U.S. and another phone for when I'm in Mexico?

No way! That would be inconvenient. You can use the same phone and AT&T wireless plan in both Mexico and the U.S.

What Latin American countries are included in this feature?

Unlimited talk, text & high-speed data while in Latin America is available when traveling to Argentina, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Guyana, Honduras, Nicaragua, Panamá, Paraguay, Perú, Suriname, Uruguay and Venezuela. This is in addition to Mexico and Canada capabilities, which are already included in our FirstNet Premium 2.0 and FirstNet Elite 2.0 Plans.

What Latin American countries are excluded in this feature?

Cuba, French Guyana and the rest of the Caribbean are not included.

What if I'm traveling outside of Mexico and the 20 Latin American countries covered by FirstNet Premium 2.0 or FirstNet Elite 2.0 plans?

Take the same plan you use at home to over 210+ destinations or use it on 400+ cruise ships with Cruise Day Pass for First Responders.
